
Two-Year Growth Comparison







School Highlight: Esplanade School SBAC ELA Result












School Highlight: West Orange School SBAC Math Result

Parent Engagement

Progress towards: 1) seeking input from parents/guardians in decision making; and 2) promoting parental participation in programs Evidence:

Continual increase in participation in annual LCAP survey and offer more opportunities for engagement during stakeholder meetings.

School Climate

Administration of local climate surveys Evidence:

Administered every other year. Students in 5th, 7th and 10th grade participated in survey by Education Department School Climate Survey (EDSCLS) Spring of 2017. Will be surveying students in February 2019 with a new climate survey to be Board approved 11/2018.









Local Performance Indicators

#7

Access to a Broad Course of Study

Progress towards the extent to which all students have access to, and are enrolled in, a broad course of study, including the programs and services developed and provide to unduplicated students and individuals with exceptional needs.

Evidence:

Increased participation in AVID, online course (Orange Live) and VAPA (all levels). Expansion of inclusive schooling and co-teaching. Increased number of CTE pathway completers and dual enrollment courses.
