
- All CTE Teachers possess an industry specific Career Technical Education Credential & Bachelor's Degree.
- All CTE Teachers must have a minimum of 2 years of industry experience to qualify for a CTE credential.
- CTE Teachers follow OUSD & OCDE Course Outline and provide a industry and 21st Century Skills curriculum to prepare students for college and career readiness.





What is CTE?

- → CTE stands for Career Technical Education
- → A multiyear sequence of courses that integrates core academic knowledge with technical and occupational knowledge to provide students with a pathway to postsecondary education and careers
- → Has a proven history of preparing students for high-demand careers that help them live their lives to the fullest





Why is CTE beneficial for OUSD Students?

- → Prepares students for college & career
- → Provides students work experience through internship opportunities
- → Provides students the academic, technical and employability skills needed for postsecondary and workplace success
 - ◆ This includes essential skills such as effective communication, critical thinking, and attention to detail
 - ◆ The hands on application of academic skills learned in other core courses provides relevance and meaning
- → Students can earn college credit &/or industry certifications by taking specific CTE courses

CTE IN OUSD

- → OUSD has an incredibly robust Career Technical Education (CTE) program which includes 12 industry sectors across our high schools.
- → Included under each industry sector are the pathway standards and performance indicators which informs instruction. OUSD has a total of 25 pathways.
- → OUSD CTE pathways align with industry credentials, certification opportunities, postsecondary training, and/or employment.
- → Our OUSD students graduate with the EDGE due to our rigorous and relevant curriculum and preparation for high-skill, high-demand careers.

What does it mean when a class is articulated?

→ An articulation agreement is formal document verifying the coursework from a high school class is equivalent to a college class.

- → Students may earn college credit by taking specific articulated CTE courses.
- → OUSD has 38 courses that provide opportunities for articulated credits.
