NATURE CENTER's 50th Anniversary

WHEREAS, the El Modena High School Nature Center/Native Plant Garden ("Nature Center") was established in 1972 by El Modena High School Science Teacher Jeanne Carter; and

WHEREAS, Director Carter has been the driving force behind the Nature Center; and

WHEREAS, the Nature Center is dedicated to the teaching of water conservation and ecological principles to students in grades K-12 and community members; and

WHEREAS, the garden occupies approximately one acre with a large pond and a 200-foot stream with two wetland areas in the stream and over 100 different native California plants; and

WHEREAS, the Nature Center has educated over 50,000 students through high school student-led tours; and

WHEREAS, there has been strong and ongoing community support for the Nature Center; and organizations such as the Orange Rotary Club, Love Orange, and Circle K (Kiwanis) from California State University, Fullerton to help build and develop the garden; and

WHEREAS, the 50th Eagle Scout Project at the Nature Center will be completed this year and each project has helped improve the Center;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordered, determined, and resolved that the Board of Education does hereby proclaim June 2, 2022, as
