Course Offerings and Locations

Professional Internship Canyon High School & El Modena High School


This practicum and internship course allows the students to apply academic and career readiness skills in a workplace environment. Instruction will combine standards-based classroom instruction with extended on-site industry experience. Students will learn all aspects of Professionalism, and apply 21st Century Skills of Communication, Collaboration, Critical Thinking, Creativity and Problem Solving in a real world setting. Students are placed in local businesses to complete the internship portion of the class.

Medical Core (UC-g) El Modena High School

This course builds on basic principles of medical science, terminology and vocabulary needed to work in the healthcare field. Students will focus on ethical and legal responsibilities of the health care worker, safety, medical terminology, human anatomy, physiology, body systems and fitness. Also included are health care delivery systems, regulatory agencies, research, current technology, and socio-economic issues affecting health care. Students gain practical hands-on experience in Vital Signs, Emergency Medical Care, and First Aid. This course meets the UC-"g" requirement.

Applications of Business Technology (UC-g) EL Modena High School

In this course, students will develop expertise in Microsoft Office applications. As students learn the different tasks involved in the daily operation of a business, and use the appropriate software and systems to complete these tasks, they also learn business theories that deal with management, entrepreneurship, and job creation. Application of Business Technology concentrates on Microsoft Office PowerPoint, Excel, Access, and Word. Instruction includes those areas and skills included on the Microsoft Office Specialist (MOS) Certification exam. This course meets the UC-"g" requirement.
