

Orange Unified School District District Advisory Council (DAC) Meeting Notes

Wednesday, May 11, 2022 9:30 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. Virtual Meeting

Dr. Gunn Marie Hansen welcomed the District Advisory Council to the meeting, held via Microsoft Teams. She reminded participants that agenda, minutes, and any other documents shared in the meeting would be sent via email after the meeting and also be posted on the DAC website. Parents can refer to the website and share information with their parent groups.

TOPICS DISCUSSED:

• LCAP Update- Elena Rodriguez, Executive Director, Accountability, Equity & Engagement

- Mrs. Rodriguez gave an update of the LCAP. She reminded everyone that the district takes input, revises the plan, put the plan into action, and monitors the progress.
- Mrs. Rodriguez also shared that the LCAP is a tool for districts to communicate goals, to plan actions and leverage the resources that will improve student outcomes.
- She reminded everyone that we're on the right track as we keep working on improvements.

• Summer School- Lisa Green, Executive Director Curriculum & Instruction

- Mrs. Green discussed that this years' summer school program will address student learning needs through interactive, engaging, and targeted instruction in all core subjects.
- Will be included STEAM Education with integrated Social Emotional Learning components for all our students.
- Mrs. Green shared about the great partnership with our local Community College Santiago Canyon College which will offer free summer classes for all OUSD students.

• <u>Orange Unified Public School Foundation Update- Joe Erven, Executive Director Innovation & Excellence</u>

- Orange Unified Public Schools Foundation mobilizes the community to provide equitable opportunities for all students to learn creatively, think innovatively, and collaborate effectively.
- Mr. Erven discussed a fundraiser to have graduate banners at Fred Kelly Stadium during all the high school graduations.
- The 1st 200 banners sold will be placed within the Fred Kelly Stadium. The banners are \$80.00. Families may purchase banners through May 17th. Additional information has been posted on social media as well as the district website.

• Employees of the Year- Ernie Gonzalez, Assistant Superintendent, Human Resources

- Mr. Ernie Gonzalez announced the Employees of the Year. The categories included, Classified Employee of the Year, Certificated Employee of the Year, and Administrator of the Year.
- He also shared that their celebration would be held on May 18, 2022, at Fred Kelly Stadium at 3:30 pm.

• Budget- Dave Rivera, Asst. Supt. Business Services

- Mr. Dave Rivera announced that Business Services will provide a report on the district budget.
- Mr. Dave Rivera also shared that by law, the district is required to update the board within a 45-day period. They referred to that as the 45-day revise of the adoption budget.
- He further elaborated that due to COVID funding expiring in the next couple years. We'd
