PUBLIC REVIEW PERIOD

AT THE BOARD MEETING ON JUNE 3, 2021, THE BOARD APPROVED A PUBLIC REVIEW PERIOD FOR THE DISTRICT'S PROPOSED NEW INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS ADOPTIONS.

FOR THE PERIOD BETWEEN JUNE 3 AND JULY 19TH, 47 PEOPLE HAVE CALLED THE OFFICE OF CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION REGARDING PARENT REVIEWS. REVIEWS ARE CONTINUING TO BE CONDUCTED BY THE OFFICE OF CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION.

REVIEWS OF SECONDARY HEALTH CURRICULUM CONDUCTED PRIOR TO OPENING OF OFFICIAL Public Review Period.

- + REVIEW OF THE SECONDARY HEALTH CURRICULUM, AND THE CALIFORNIA HEALTHY YOUTH ACT (CHYA) LEGISLATION, HAS BEEN FACILITATED AT THE DISTRICT OFFICE AND SECONDARY CAMPUSES SINCE 2017.
- + IN THE 2017-2018 SCHOOL YEAR
 - + 519 PARENTS REVIEWED CURRICULUM/LEGISLATION AT EITHER THE DISTRICT OFFICE OR SCHOOL SITES.
 - 190 PARENTS REVIEWED CURRICULUM/LEGISLATION THROUGH OUR VARIOUS ADVISORY COMMITTEES: PARENT TEACHER ASSOCIATION (PTA), DISTRICT ADVISORY COUNCIL (DAC), DISTRICT ENGLISH LEARNER ADVISORY COMMITTEE (DELAC), GIFTED AND TALENTED EDUCATION COMMUNITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE (GATE CAC), & SPECIAL EDUCATION COMMUNITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE (SPED CAC.).
 - + THE OFFICE OF CURRICULUM & INSTRUCTION ALSO HAD 211 PHONE CONVERSATIONS WITH PARENTS AND COMMUNITY MEMBERS WHO HAD QUESTIONS AND/OR CONCERNS ABOUT CURRICULUM AND CHYA LEGISLATION.
- + In the 2018–2019 school year, 426 parents reviewed curriculum/legislation at the high-schools and the Office of Curriculum & Instruction staff continued to clarify CHYA legislation via phone and by responding to a newly created online input question form.

REVIEWS OF SECONDARY HEALTH CURRICULUM CONDUCTED PRIOR TO OPENING OF OFFICIAL Public Review Period.

- + THE COMPREHENSIVE SEXUAL HEALTH EDUCATION CURRICULUM REVIEW COMMITTEE (CRC) CONVENED

 2019 AND RECEIVED PARENT COMMUNITY INPUT FROM THE ONLINE QUESTION FORM.
- + FOLLOWING THEIR RECOMMENDATION, IN 2020 ALL SCHOOL CAMPUSES BEGAN A REVIEW OF THE HEALTH CURRICULUM AND LEGISLATION AT PARENT MEETINGS.
- + ALTHOUGH THESE REVIEWS STARTED IN THE 2019/2020 SCHOOL YEAR, THEY WERE MALLY COMPLETED LAST SCHOOL YEAR DUE TO THE PANDEMIC.
- + Through these review forums, approximately 400 parents participated with an additional 207 parents reviewing curriculum through our various Advisory Committees: *PTA*, *DAC*, *DELAC*, *GATE CAC*, & SPED CAC.
- + DELAC AND ELAC PRESENTATIONS WERE IN SPANISH. OTHER COMMUNITY AND SCHOOL SITE MEETINGS OFFERED INTERPRETATION, AS NEEDED.

- + REVIEWERS ARE GIVEN A FORM TO PROVIDE FEEDBACK. THEY CAN ALSO PROVIDE FEEDBACK LATER, USING A QR CODE. MAJORITY OF COMMENTS WERE POSITIVE.
