




#### MEASURE S BOND PROGRAM - PHASE I: SCHEDULE SUMMARY






#### MEASURE S BOND PROGRAM - PHASE I: SCHEDULE SUMMARY






#### MEASURE S BOND PROGRAM - PHASE II: SCHEDULE SUMMARY
