Dave Rivera shared that there was a tremendous response from the community during the ceremony, and that the District will plan for larger numbers of attendees at future "Topping Out" events. Rory Lorenzo explained the details to the Villa Park Science Center change orders, and Scott Harvey showed photos of the structural steel in place. Mr. Harvey concluded his presentation by sharing photos of the interim kitchen at Canyon High School, which is in the final stages. Member Shah asked when the Annual Financial Audit would be shared with the COC members. Dave Rivera responded by saying that the Audit will be shared at the January 22nd COC meeting. Member Utter asked about what work will be done at the Orange High School theater, and Scott Harvey responded by saying that they will not reconstruct the theatre, but facility upgrades will be done to the theatre to renovate the interior.
