Board Meetings

Regular Board meetings are typically scheduled the second and fourth Thursday of each month at 7:00 p.m. at the Orange Unified School District Education Center, 1401 North Handy Street, Building H. The purpose of the Board meeting is to conduct business. This is done in **Open Session**. Matters dealing with students and employees are reserved for **Closed Session** to provide confidentiality as required by law. Other Closed Session topics include: pending litigation, property negotiations and collective bargaining issues with employee associations.

Special Board Meetings

Meeting notices for **special meetings** are posted 24 hours in advance of the meeting and shall indicate the business to be transacted at the meeting. No other business shall be considered at the special meeting. The public will be provided an opportunity to address the item described in the notice.

Emergency Board Meetings

When the Board determines that an emergency situation exists, it may call an **emergency meeting**. The Board may hold an emergency meeting without complying with the 24-hour notice or 24-hour posting requirement for special meetings pursuant to Government Code 54956. The Board shall comply with all other requirements for a special meeting during an emergency meeting.

Agendas

Agendas contain a brief description of each item to be discussed or transacted at the meeting. Copies of the agenda are available in the Superintendent's Office, Building B, at the District Education Center or on the web site at www.orangeusd.k12.ca.us/board/calendar.asp.

Consent Items are routine in nature and generally require no discussion. These items are acted upon by one motion; however, any such item may be considered separately at a Board member's request. **Action Items** are acted upon separately. Board members may ask questions or request that staff make a presentation before voting on an item. **Information/Discussion Items** do not require action by the Board. The Board may take action only on those items listed in the printed agenda, except for emergencies.

Any member of the public may request that a matter within the jurisdiction of the Board be placed on the agenda of a regular meeting. The request must be in writing and submitted to the Superintendent at least ten working days before the scheduled meeting date.

Addressing the Board

Persons wishing to address the Board are requested to fill out a "Public Comment" **blue card** available at the meeting on the information table. The "Public Comment" card should be submitted to the Superintendent or the Board Clerk prior to the start of open session.

Speakers are limited to three (3) minutes per speaker with a maximum of twenty (20) minutes per topic. With Board consent, the Board President may modify the time allowed for public presentation. **Power Point and computer presentations are not allowed.** A speaker may not relinquish his/her time to another. When addressing the Board, speakers are requested to state their name for the record and address the Board from the podium. If the topic has been previously addressed, it is requested that the speaker's remarks be limited to **new points only**.

Speakers will be called upon at the appropriate time during the meeting. Agenda items may be addressed during the Board's consideration of the item. Items **not on the agenda** that are within the Board's subject matter jurisdiction may be addressed during the "Public Comment" section. Items not on the agenda may not be acted on or discussed by the Board, but will be researched and responded to in any one of the following ways: 1) by telephone after research; 2) by mail after research; or 3) at a subsequent Board meeting as an agenda item.

No boisterous conduct shall be permitted at any Board meeting. Persistent boisterous conduct shall be grounds for summary termination by the Board President of that person's privilege of address.

"Any person who willfully disturbs any public school or any public school meeting is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500)."(CEC § 32210)

Complaints against employees will normally be heard in Closed Session. The District's complaint procedure should be followed before discussion with the Board.

Requests for Information

Requests for information shall be made in writing and submitted to the Superintendent's Office. There is a nominal charge of \$.10 per page for copies of public records.

ACTION ITEMS

TOPIC: PUBLIC HEARING ON THE SUFFICIENCY OF TEXTBOOKS, INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS AND SCIENCE LAB EQUIPMENT (9-12) AND ADOPTION OF BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 09-09-10

DESCRIPTION: The Williams Settlement set a specific timeline for districts in certifying the sufficiency of textbooks, instructional materials, and science lab equipment (9-12). The settlement requires the hearing to be held prior to the end of the eighth week after the first day pupils attend school. Education Code Section 60119 and 60422(b) specifies that the governing boards of school districts establish steps and procedures and take appropriate action to ensure the availability of textbooks and instructional materials on a yearly basis:

1. Hold a public hearing.
2. Make a determination, through a resolution, on the status of the sufficiency or insufficiency of textbooks and instructional materials in the district and that they are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum framework adopted by the State Board in the following areas:
 - Mathematics
 - Science
 - History/Social Science
 - English/Language Arts, including the English Language Development component of an adopted program
 - Foreign Language
 - Health
 - Visual and Performing Arts
3. Make a determination, through a resolution, on the status of the availability of laboratory sciences equipment as applicable to science laboratory courses offered in grades 9 to 12 inclusive.

The District has posted, as required by law, a notice of public hearing ten days in advance of this evening's hearing, and the attached Resolution satisfies the requirements of the Timeline for Implementation of the Williams Settlement Legislation.

FISCAL IMPACT: Adoption of the resolution has no fiscal impact.

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board of Education hold a public hearing, adopt Resolution No. 09-09-10, and certify to the California Department of Education that the District has complied with the requirement of Education Code Section 60119(c) and 60422(b).

**RESOLUTION NO. 09-09-10
OF THE
ORANGE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT GOVERNING BOARD**

**DETERMINING STEPS TO ENSURE AVAILABILITY OF TEXTBOOKS
AND INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS FOR 2009-2010**

WHEREAS, Education Code Section 60119 establishes steps and procedures to ensure the availability of textbooks and instructional materials in order to be eligible to receive funds for that purpose; and,

WHEREAS, the procedures require that school districts take appropriate action to ensure the availability of textbooks and instructional materials on a yearly basis; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code Sections 60119 and 60422(b), the Board is required to hold a public hearing to encourage participation by parents, teachers, members of the community interested in the affairs of the school district, and bargaining unit leaders; and,

WHEREAS, the Board is required to provide 10 days notice of the public hearing or hearings, and;

WHEREAS, the notice shall contain the time, place, and purpose of the hearing and be posted in three public places within the school district; and,

WHEREAS, the hearing shall be held at a time that will encourage the attendance of teachers and parents and guardians of pupils who attend the schools in the district and shall not take place during or immediately following school hours; and,

WHEREAS, the governing Board of a school district, as part of the required hearing, shall also make a written determination as to whether each pupil enrolled in a foreign language or health course has sufficient textbooks or instructional materials that are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum frameworks adopted by the state board for those subjects; and,

WHEREAS, the governing Board shall also determine the availability of laboratory science equipment as applicable to science laboratory courses offered in grades 9 to 12, inclusive; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on October 15, 2009, which is on or before the eighth week of school and;

WHEREAS, the Board is required to make a determination, through a resolution, as to whether each pupil in each school in the district has sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, or both, that are aligned to the content standards adopted pursuant to Education Code Section 60605 in each of the following subjects, as appropriate, that are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum framework adopted by the State Board:

- (i.) Mathematics
- (ii.) Science
- (iii.) History-Social science

- (iv.) English/Language arts, including the English language development component of an adopted program.
- (v.) Visual and performing arts

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the governing Board makes the determination that each pupil of the District, has available sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, or both, that are aligned to the content standards adopted pursuant to Education Code Section 60605 in each subject listed above, consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum framework adopted by the State Board and adopted by this Board in accordance with the procedures as established.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that for the 2009-2010 school year the Orange Unified School District has provided each pupil with sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, or both, that are aligned to the content standards adopted pursuant to Education Code Section 60605 in each subject listed above, consistent with the content and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum framework adopted by the State Board for those subjects.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that for the 2009-2010 school year the Orange Unified School District has provided sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, or both, that are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum frameworks adopted by the State Board, to each pupil enrolled in a foreign language or health course, and that sufficient laboratory science equipment applicable to science laboratory courses offered in grades 9 - 12, inclusive, is available to pupils.

TOPIC: **LEGISLATIVE COALITION UPDATE**

DESCRIPTION: The OUSD Legislative Coalition, formed in 1979, is a committee that works with the District to inform and update the Board of Education and staff on legislative issues that directly affect the District. DESCRIPTION: Purchase orders and change orders have been processed in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Board of Education and applicable legal requirements of the State of California.

District procedures and computer system controls require that an approved purchase order, pay voucher, current liability, or credit memo exist on the District's computer system prior to the issuance of warrants. There may be a multiple number of warrants drawn against a given purchase order up to the maximum amount for that purchase order. The system restricts the processing of payment amounts in excess of the issued purchase order

It should be noted that the purchase order system allows for a one-line description of the services or items to be procured. The issued purchase order forms a contract between the District and the vendor.

DESCRIPTION: Authorization of signatures is an item which is routinely updated to reflect changes in personnel and to comply with the requirements of the California Education Code.

As the agency which ultimately releases District payrolls and warrants, the Orange County Department of Education (OCDE) must maintain on file the approved signature authorizations for all school districts. The signatures are applicable to various documents which are approved by the Board of Education and in compliance with the Education Code and other pertinent state and federal laws. The administrative/leadership employees for whom the signature authorizations are designated do not transfer that authority to any staff members.

Purchase orders are processed within the limitations of existing site/program budgets, with the P.O. listing submitted to the Board at each meeting. Non-routine expenditures for consultants, contracts, major facility additions, etc. are submitted to the Board separately for authorization. Before the preparation of a warrant, it is determined that the proper authorization and approvals exist. Warrants prepared by the District are forwarded to the OCDE for review of documentation, county signature, and entry to OUSD's county ledgers before they are returned to the District for release to vendors, consultants, or contractors. Purchase orders, bid documents, warrants, payrolls, federal/state/county documents, etc. are audited by the District's independent audit firm.

FISCAL IMPACT: This item has no fiscal impact.

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board of Education adopt Resolution No. 10-09-10 granting signature authorization for specific District administrative/leadership employees as indicated on the attached document.

AB430 TRAINING**

The Orange County Department of Education, a State Board of Education approved AB430 training provider, will provide training to administrators of the District. AB430 is a required course for administrators of Program Improvement schools. It also fulfills the requirements for the second tier of the Administrative credential. The AB430 training for District administrators focuses on building principals' leadership skills and capacity to serve effectively in their critical and complex roles. The goal of AB430 is to develop principals who come from a variety of contexts and challenging environments, who are able to establish sound and clear instructional goals, who collaboratively develop data-driven instructional strategies, and who lead a school through powerful instructional change.

The AB430 training for administrators will cover the following areas: Module I – Leadership and Support of Student Instructional Programs, Module II – Leadership and Management for Instructional Improvement, and Module III – Instructional Technology to Improve Pupil Performance. AB430 training is to take place for several days out of each year for two years starting July 1, 2009 and ending June 30, 2011. Fiscal impact will be the expenditure of restricted categorical fund monies.

DESCRIPTION

Villa Park High School - Boys Water Polo Team – Atherton, CA – October 23-24, 2009

Villa Park High's Boys Water Polo Team under the direction of John Carcich, will travel to Atherton to participate in the North-South Challenge Boys Varsity Water Polo Tournament state competition. Villa Park High will represent the south as one of the top eight teams competing with high schools from other parts of the state, exposing the athletes to top ranked state competition and introducing them to top academic programs in California. McPherson Magnet's 7th grade classes under the direction of Lynne Palucki, will travel to the Desert Sun Science Center to attend Astro Camp. The students will study the solar system, rocketry, electricity, magnetism and Newton's Laws of Physics through a hands-on interactive program emphasizing teamwork and cooperation. Motion, Forces, Earth into the Solar System, Reaction, Periodic Tables, and Investigation and Experimentation science standards will be covered. Forty-five female and forty-five male students will be accompanied by four female and two male adult teacher/chaperones and will stay in the Science Center dormitories. Villa Park High School - Foreign Language Immersion Camp
(German) - Big Bear, CA – February 26–28, 2010

Villa Park High's Foreign Language Department under the direction of Elizabeth Strauss, will travel to Big Bear to participate in a German Language Immersion Camp. Students will have the opportunity to converse, only in German, with students from other schools. The camp focuses on every strand of the foreign language content standards while providing students with invaluable preparation for the AP Test. Five female and five male students will be accompanied by one female and five male adult chaperones and will stay at the Presbyterian Conference Center, Big Bear. Parents will provide transportation for their student to Esperanza High School where students will board and travel by Silver State Coach, arranged by the District's Transportation Department. The cost per student is \$140 and scholarships are available. Students will miss one day of school. A substitute will be required. Substitutes and transportation to be funded by boosters.

Villa Park High School - Foreign Language Immersion Camp
(French) - Big Bear, CA – March 5–7, 2010

Villa Park High's Foreign Language Department under the direction of Fatima Pazargadi, will travel to Big Bear to participate in a French Language Immersion Camp. Students will have the opportunity to converse, only in French, with students from other schools. The camp focuses on every strand of the foreign language content standards while providing students with invaluable preparation for the AP test. Five female and five male students will be accompanied by four female and three male adult chaperones and will stay at the Presbyterian Conference Center, Big Bear. Parents will provide transportation for their student to Esperanza High School where students will board and travel by Silver State Coach, arranged by the District's Transportation Department. The cost per student is \$140 and scholarships are available. Students will not any school days. A substitute will not be required. Transportation to be funded by boosters.

Serrano Elementary - 4th Grade Class – Ocean Institute, Dana Point – March 11 – 12, 2010

The fourth grade students from Serrano Elementary School, under the direction of Dana Vigneault and Celeste Ivory, will travel to the Ocean Institute in Dana Point to participate in "The Pilgrim Overnight" program. Students will participate in a re-enactment of life on a tall ship of the 1800s. The program correlates with the Social Studies curriculum. The cost will not exceed \$100 per student, and scholarships are available. There is no impact to the general fund. The student cost may be supplemented by funds donated from individual parent organizations.

Anaheim Hills and Imperial Elementary - 6th Grade Classes – Irvine Ranch - Outdoor Education Center – March 22 – 26, 2010

The sixth grade students from Anaheim Hills and Imperial Elementary Schools will participate in the YMCA of Metropolitan Los Angeles Camping Services, Camp Whittle program. This five-day program provides students an opportunity to study science in a natural setting. Students will have the opportunity to explore established trails, investigate geological features, observe wildlife and compare plant adaptations. Students will study the night sky through telescopes, participate in line and folk dances and create and perform science and nature skits. All curriculum is based on California State Standards. The cost will not exceed \$300 per student, and scholarships are available. There is no impact to the general fund. The student cost may be supplemented by funds donated from individual parent organizations.

FISCAL IMPACT

Receipt of restricted categorical fund monies and unrestricted donated funds.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board of Education approve the study trips as presented.

TOPIC: **CERTIFICATION OF PROVISION OF STANDARDS -
ALIGNED INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS**

The texts are available for review in the Board Room this evening and after tonight in the Instructional Media Center. After the 30-day review period, the Board of Education may take formal action to adopt the textbooks and/or supplementary texts.

FISCAL IMPACT: Textbooks will be purchased from the textbook accounts during the 2009/2010 school year. Intervention/supplemental adoptions are used to supplement the basic textbook and are purchased with funds other than the state textbook monies.
