Board Meetings

Regular Board meetings are typically scheduled the second and fourth Thursday of each month at 7:00 p.m. at the ●range Unified School District Education Center, 1401 North Handy Street, Building H. The purpose of the Board meeting is to conduct business. This is done in **Open Session**. Matters dealing with students and employees are reserved for **Closed Session** to provide confidentiality as required by law. Other Closed Session topics include: pending litigation, property negotiations and collective bargaining issues with employee associations.

Special Board Meetings

Meeting notices for **special meetings** are posted 24 hours in advance of the meeting and shall indicate the business to be transacted at the meeting. No other business shall be considered at the special meeting. The public will be provided an opportunity to address the item described in the notice.

Emergency Board Meetings

When the Board determines that an emergency situation exists, it may call an **emergency meeting**. The Board may hold an emergency meeting without complying with the 24-hour notice or 24-hour posting requirement for special meetings pursuant to Government Code 54956. The Board shall comply with all other requirements for a special meeting during an emergency meeting.

Agendas

Agendas contain a brief description of each item to be discussed or transacted at the meeting. Copies of the agenda are available in the Superintendent's Office, Building B, at the District Education Center or on the web site at **www.orangeusd.k12.ca.us/board/calendar.asp.**

Consent Items are routine in nature and generally require no discussion. These items are acted upon by one motion; however, any such item may be considered separately at a Board member's request. Action Items are acted upon separately. Board members may ask questions or request that staff make a presentation before voting on an item. Information/Discussion Items do not require action by the Board. The Board may take action only on those items listed in the printed agenda, except for emergencies.

Any member of the public may request that a matter within the jurisdiction of the Board be placed on the agenda of a regular meeting. The request must be in writing and submitted to the Superintendent at least ten working days before the scheduled meeting date.

Addressing the Board

Persons wishing to address the Board are requested to fill out a "Public Comment" **blue card** available at the meeting on the information table. The "Public Comment" card should be submitted to the Superintendent or the Board Clerk prior to the start of open session.

Speakers are limited to three (3) minutes per speaker with a maximum of twenty (20) minutes per topic. With Board consent, the Board President may modify the time allowed for public presentation. **Power Point and computer presentations are <u>not</u> allowed.** A speaker may not relinquish his/her time to another. When addressing the Board, speakers are requested to state their name for the record and address the Board from the podium. If the topic has been previously addressed, it is requested that the speaker's remarks be limited to **new points only**.

Speakers will be called upon at the appropriate time during the meeting. Agenda items may be addressed during the Board's consideration of the item. Items **not on the agenda** that are within the Board's subject matter jurisdiction may be addressed during the "Public Comment" section. Items not on the agenda may not be acted on or discussed by the Board, but will be researched and responded to in any one of the following ways: 1) by telephone after research; 2) by mail after research; or 3) at a subsequent Board meeting as an agenda item.

No boisterous conduct shall be permitted at any Board meeting. Persistent boisterous conduct shall be grounds for summary termination by the Board President of that person's privilege of address.

"Any person who willfully disturbs any public school or any public school meeting is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500)." (CEC § 32210)

Complaints against employees will normally be heard in Closed Session. The District's complaint procedure should be followed before discussion with the Board.

Requests for Information

Requests for information shall be made in writing and submitted to the Superintendent's Office. There is a nominal charge of \$.10 per page for copies of public records.

PUBLIC HEARING ON THE SUFFICIENCY OF TEXTBOOKS. INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS AND SCIENCE LAB ADOPTION OF EQUIPMENT (9-12) AND **BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 09-09-10**

DESCRIPTION:

The Williams Settlement set a specific timeline for districts in certifying the sufficiency of textbooks, instructional materials, and science lab equipment (9-12). The settlement requires the hearing to be held prior to the end of the eighth week after the first day pupils attend school. Education Code Section 60119 and 60422(b) specifies that the governing boards of school districts establish steps and procedures and take appropriate action to ensure the availability of textbooks and instructional materials on a yearly basis:

- 1. Hold a public hearing.
- 2. Make a determination, through a resolution, on the status of the sufficiency or insufficiency of textbooks and instructional materials in the district and that they are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum framework adopted by the State Board in the following areas:
 - Mathematics
 - Science
 - History/Social Science
 - · English/Language Arts, including the English Language Development component of an adopted program
 - Foreign Language
 - Health
 - Visual and Performing Arts
- 3. Make a determination, through a resolution, on the status of the availability of laboratory sciences equipment as applicable to science laboratory courses offered in grades 9 to 12 inclusive.

The District has posted, as required by law, a notice of public hearing ten days in advance of this evening's hearing, and the attached Resolution satisfies the requirements of the Timeline for Implementation of the Williams Settlement Legislation.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Adoption of the resolution has no fiscal impact.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board of Education hold a public hearing, adopt Resolution No. 09-09-10, and certify to the California Department of Education that the District has complied with the requirement of Education Code Section 601 19(c) and 60422(b).

RESOLUTION NO. 09-09-10 OF THE ORANGE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT GOVERNING BOARD

DETERMINING STEPS TO ENSURE AVAILABILITY OF TEXTBOOKS AND INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS FOR 2009-2010

WHEREAS, Education Code Section 60119 establishes steps and procedures to ensure the availability of textbooks and instructional materials in order to be eligible to receive funds for that purpose; and,

WHEREAS, the procedures require that school districts take appropriate action to ensure the availability of textbooks and instructional materials on a yearly basis; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code Sections 60119 and 60422(b), the Board is required to hold a public hearing to encourage participation by parents, teachers, members of the community interested in the affairs of the school district, and bargaining unit leaders; and,

WHEREAS, the Board is required to provide 10 days notice of the public hearing or hearings, and;

WHEREAS, the notice shall contain the time, place, and purpose of the hearing and be posted in three public places within the school district; and,

WHEREAS, the hearing shall be held at a time that will encourage the attendance of teachers and parents and quardians of pupils who attend the schools in the district and shall not take place during or immediately following school hours; and,

WHEREAS, the governing Board of a school district, as part of the required hearing. shall also make a written determination as to whether each pupil enrolled in a foreign language or health course has sufficient textbooks or instructional materials that are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum frameworks adopted by the state board for those subjects: and.

WHEREAS, the governing Board shall also determine the availability of laboratory science equipment as applicable to science laboratory courses offered in grades 9 to 12, inclusive; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on October 15, 2009, which is on or before the eighth week of school and;

WHEREAS, the Board is required to make a determination, through a resolution, as to whether each pupil in each school in the district has sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, or both, that are aligned to the content standards adopted pursuant to Education Code Section 60605 in each of the following subjects, as appropriate, that are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum framework adopted by the State Board:

- (i.) Mathematics
- (ii.) Science
- (iii.) History-Social science

- (iv.) English/Language arts, including the English language development component of an adopted program.
- (v.) Visual and performing arts

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the governing Board makes the determination that each pupil of the District, has available sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, or both, that are aligned to the content standards adopted pursuant to Education Code Section 60605 in each subject listed above, consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum framework adopted by the State Board and adopted by this Board in accordance with the procedures as established.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that for the 2009-2010 school year the Orange Unified School District has provided each pupil with sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, or both, that are aligned to the content standards adopted pursuant to Education Code Section 60605 in each subject listed above, consistent with the content and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum framework adopted by the State Board for those subjects.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that for the 2009-2010 school year the Orange Unified School District has provided sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, or both, that are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum frameworks adopted by the State Board, to each pupil enrolled in a foreign language or health course, and that sufficient laboratory science equipment applicable to science laboratory courses offered in grades 9 - 12, inclusive, is available to pupils.

The District awarded Bid No. FC6019 – Modernization – Yorba Middle School to J.D. Diffenbaugh, Inc., on June 18, 2009. Change Orders 1 and 2, increase the value of the contract and do not add any additional time to the contract. The cost and scope were reviewed and found to be reasonable by the architect, construction manager and staff. This Change Order falls within the allowable maximum of 10% per the Public Contract Code.

DRIFTWOOD DAIRY Bid No. 614

Bid No. 614 is for the award of a price agreement for dairy products. As required by Public Contract Code, the District advertised in the Orange City News on September 3 & 10, 2009. In addition to the required Public Notice, seven dairies were notified. Three dairies submitted bids which were opened on September 21, 2009 at 9:00 a.m. Bids were based on the District's estimated annual dairy product usage. The bid will allow the District to procure dairy products on an as-needed basis at competitively bid prices for up to three years. It is recommended that the Board award Bid No. 614 - Dairy Products to the lowest responsible bidder, Driftwood Dairy. This is not a request for any additional budgetary appropriation. INTERSCHOLASTIC TRADING COMPANY. LLC dba **INTERSCHOLA**

Interscholastic Trading Company, LLC (Interschola) provides services to K-12 school districts, county offices of education and other educational institutions by assisting with the selling of surplus items in an online auction environment, using eBay as a primary sales channel. The program is in compliance with Ed. Code 17545-17546 (Procedures for Sales of Surplus Personal Property) and has been implemented approximately 300 school districts throughout California, including 15 in Orange County, and the Orange County Department of Education. Initial term of the agreement is for one year. Fees range from 28% to 48% depending on the revenue generated from sales.

The District awarded Bid No. 589 - Asphalt Replacement -Anaheim Hills Elementary to Terra Pave Inc. on May 12, 2009. Change Order 1, increases the value of the contract and does not add any additional time to the contract. The cost and scope were reviewed and found to be reasonable by staff. This Change Order falls within the allowable maximum of 10% per the Public Contract Code.

MARK J. PAONE ARCHITECTURE

The District has a need for services of design professionals for consultation purposed throughout the year to assist with the closing out old DSA projects. Paone Architecture has the experience necessary to provide these services. Approval will allow staff to consult with this firm on an as-needed basis for the 2009-10 fiscal year.

ORANGE CHILDREN & **PARENTS TOGETHER**

Orange Children & Parents Together (OCPT) has provided licensed preschool services on various District sites in prior years. OCPT wishes to continue to use District facilities to provide licensed preschool services to preschool-age children for the current school year. This agreement allows OCPT to use classrooms at California, Handy and Taft Elementary Schools and a fenced area of the playfield at Lampson Elementary School.

The agreement covers the cost of utilities and custodial service for the District provided facilities (classrooms). The agreement is effective September 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010. Any continuation of the program beyond the current school year will require a new agreement wherein OCPT will compensate the District for utilizing classroom and playground space.

Revenue to the District......\$12,375 (Christensen/Brown)

\$408,298

AUTHORIZATION

DESCRIPTION: Authorization of signatures is an item which is routinely updated to reflect changes in personnel and to comply with the requirements of the California Education Code.

> As the agency which ultimately releases District payrolls and warrants, the Orange County Department of Education (OCDE) must maintain on file the approved signature authorizations for all school districts. The signatures are applicable to various documents which are approved by the Board of Education and in compliance with the Education Code and other pertinent state and federal laws. administrative/leadership employees for whom the signature authorizations are designated do not transfer that authority to any staff members.

> Purchase orders are processed within the limitations of existing site/program budgets, with the P.O. listing submitted to the Board at each meeting. Non-routine expenditures for consultants, contracts, major facility additions, etc. are submitted to the Board separately for authorization. Before the preparation of a warrant, it is determined that the proper authorization and approvals exist. Warrants prepared by the District are forwarded to the OCDE for review of documentation, county signature, and entry to OUSD's county ledgers before they are returned to the District for release to vendors, consultants, or contractors. Purchase orders. bid documents. warrants. payrolls. federal/state/county documents, etc. are audited by the District's independent audit firm.

The IMAC committee is composed of principals, media specialists, and teachers whose responsibility is to recommend to the Board of Education approval of the considered texts

It is at this juncture that the Board of Education places the texts and/or supplementary texts on "30-day review period" so members from the public may have an opportunity to review those texts, pending formal adoption. The texts are available for review in the Board Room this evening and after tonight in the Instructional Media Center. After the 30-day review period, the Board of Education may take formal action to adopt the textbooks and/or supplementary texts.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Textbooks will be purchased from the textbook accounts during the 2009/2010 school year. Intervention/supplemental adoptions are used to supplement the basic textbook and are purchased with funds other than the state textbook monies.
