Certificated Personnel

Certification

The Superintendent or designee shall ensure that persons employed in positions requiring certification qualifications have the appropriate credential or permit authorizing their employment in such positions. (cf. 4111 - Recruitment and Selection) (cf. 4112.21 - District Interns) (cf. 4113 - Assignment) (cf. 4116 - Probationary/Permanent Status) (cf. 4131.5 - Professional Growth)

When fully credentialed individuals are not available, the District may employ persons with emergency permits in accordance with law.

The District will facilitate and support the professional development of persons with emergency permits so that they may become fully qualified teachers. The Superintendent or designee shall develop a plan which meets the requirements of law.
