Overview

The iPilot program provides teachers the opportunity to receive a variety of instructional technology tools for their classroom use in exchange for providing feedback pertaining to the potential instructional enhancements by using each tool. This program is run with new device cohorts every month through the school year and is a great opportunity for teachers to receive and implement new devices for classroom and student use.

Details

- Educational Technology sends out an email asking teachers if they would like to participate.
- Applications are anonymously ranked and winners notified via email.
- District Educational Technology Instructional Specialists will visit with each participant 3 times.
- Complete requirements outlined below.
