The CRC will review all Adolescent Sexual Health Working Group (ASHWG) recommended comprehensive sexual health education curricula in order to compile findings and provide recommendations to be presented to District Advisory Groups and District Curriculum Council.

- attend all CRC meetings.
- review all recommended curricula utilizing a rubric
- compile findings and provide recommendations to be presented to District Curriculum Council.
