1. Welcome

2. Educational Services Update

Presenter: Dr. Gunn Marie Hansen

- Dr. Hansen thanked everyone for stepping in during this time of distance learning
- Working on plans for when students can return to school
- Feedback from parent survey shows that 20-30% of families don't feel safe having student comeback to physical instruction
- OUSD will work on practicing social distancing at the school sites
- Working hard on planning for classroom configuration
 - o Possibly 15 students per classroom
 - Working with architects
- Orange County currently does not have guidelines for reopening of schools
- OUSD is planning for three scenarios

3. Spanish for Spanish Speakers Instructional Materials Recommendation Presenter: Lisa Green

- Textbook adoption for Spanish of Spanish Speakers grades 7-12
- Recommendation is for publisher Vista Higher Learning's Galeria
- This textbook aligns with AP Spanish
- First Spanish Language Arts program produced for Spanish heritage speakers
- Differentiated content instruction for different learning modalities, abilities and needs
- Extensive and intensive language practice and application to other content areas
- Provides a variety of interactive resources with immediate corrective feedback
- Offers integrated audios, music, video and presentations to student and teacher dashboards
- Online resources are great, especially during this time of distance learning
- The plan is to have this textbook delivered to the school sites by the Fall
