

Students can share their learning with a wider audience. Provides an ongoing platform for parents to connect with child's education.


To create a sense of ownership over one's accomplishments.

Portfolios help students find their passion and purpose through reflection and goal setting.


Why Create a Digital Portfolio?

#### Time Magazine

#### Description:

For the Time Magazine we chose a famous person in ancient Egypt to write about. After we wrote about them we researched and did articles about the specific time period when that person was living there. We also had ads, games, and puzzles. The project was graded on design, layout, information, and completion.

#### Reflection:



For my sixth grade Time Magazine we were able to do lots of research on any important ancient Egyptian figure and the daily life in Egypt durning when that figure was living. I did pharaoh queen Hatshepsut and the time period of about 1464 B.C. I had to write articles in a point of the reporter that is living in that time period. I enjoyed writing in this perspective because I felt more connected with the information so was easier to remember. I also enjoyed how we used columns in our articles so it was more like a magazine. Although I wish we could have more time to write the articles, we had to do an average of 4 a week! I would definitely do the Time Magazine again if I had the choice!

#### **Proficiencies:**

Researching and reporting on events from Ancient Egypt, students will create articles and ads sharing what they have learned about a specific time period. The final published product will be done using magazine layout, incorporating design skills learned throughout the project. Living History Day, an exciting culminating day of celebration, allows students to dress and dramatize on historical figure from Ancient Egypt. Costumes and speeches, feasting and games round out the day!
