CEQA* Review

CEQA Compliance Options

Categorical Exemption	If a site-specific school project does not increase original student capacity by 25% or 10 classrooms, whichever is less, then a CEQA Class 14 Exemption (Section 15314 – Minor Additions to Schools) may be applicable for that school.
Negative Declaration	If no significant impacts have been identified for the proposed project
Mitigated Negative Declaration	Identifies mitigation measures if minor impacts that are less than significant can be mitigated to less than significant for the proposed project
Environmental Impact Report	If significant impacts have been identified for the proposed project
