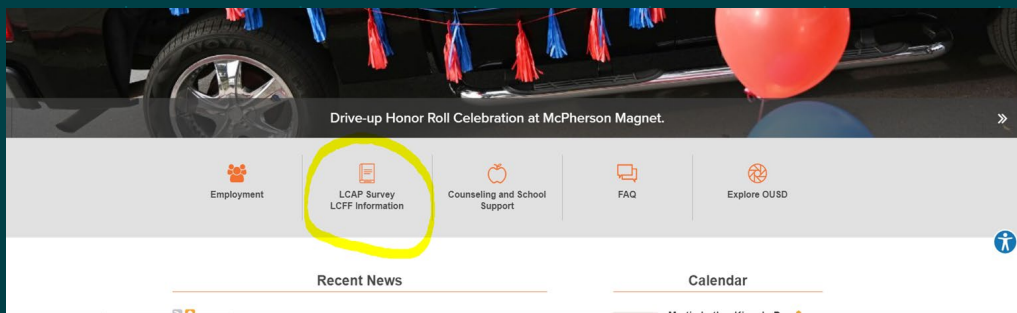

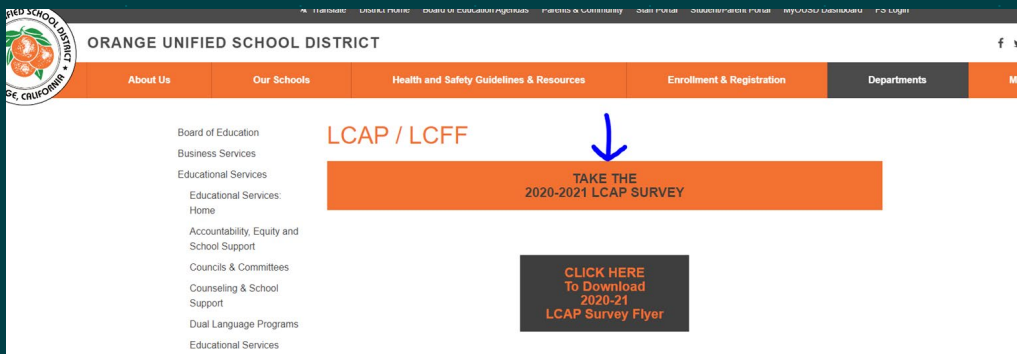


6 How to find the LCAP survey on website:
