- ◆ Students can take up to 12 units a year
- ◆ Courses are housed at our school sites
- ◆ Courses meet the interest of students by site
- ◆ Emphasis on math acceleration
- ◆ Focus on CTE pathway and academy connections

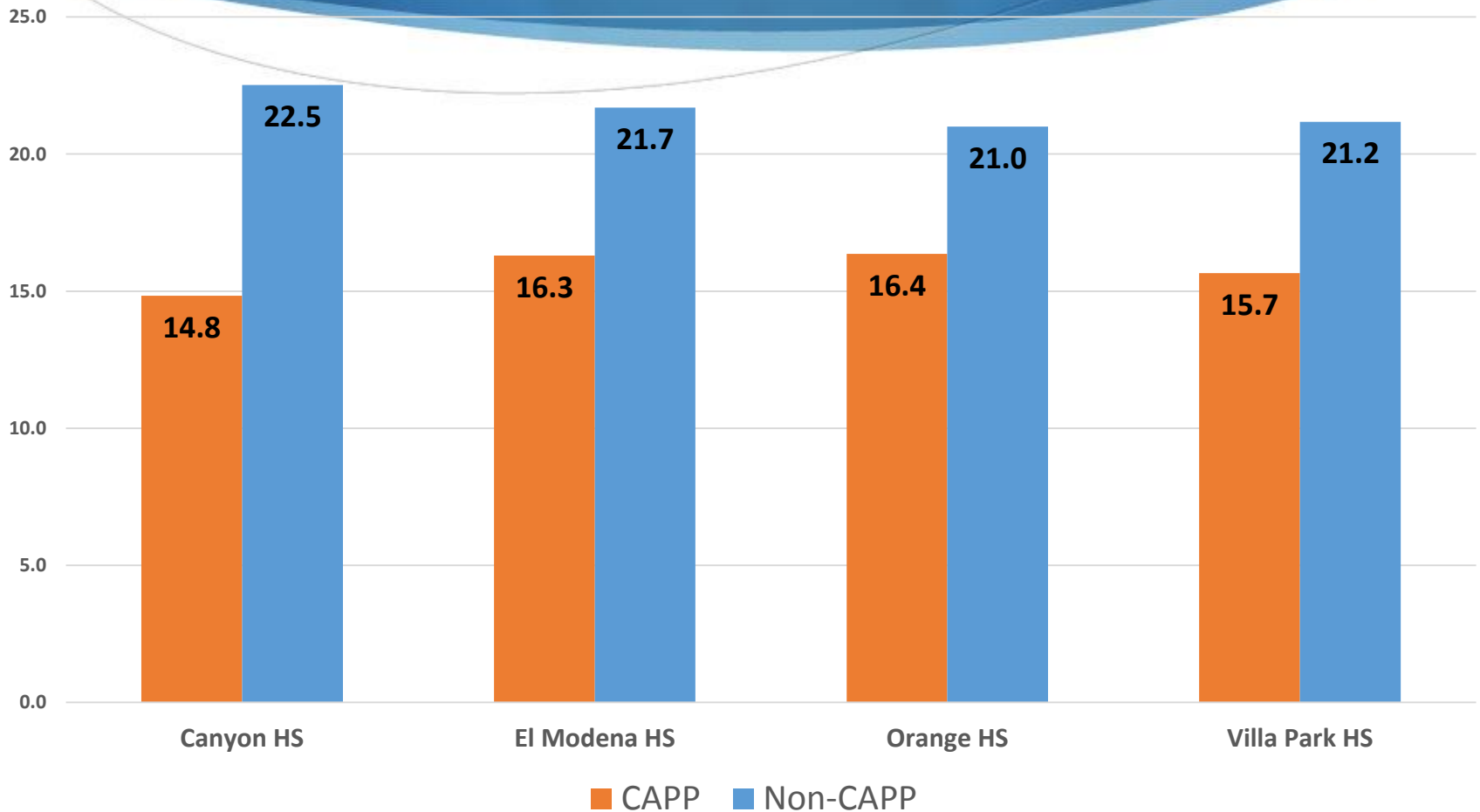


# Why Dual Enrollment?

- Students earn both high school and college credit
- More likely to graduate from high school
- More likely to transition to a 4-year college
- More likely to persist in postsecondary education
- Less likely to take basic skills courses in college
- Accumulate more college credits
- Increased access to career choice

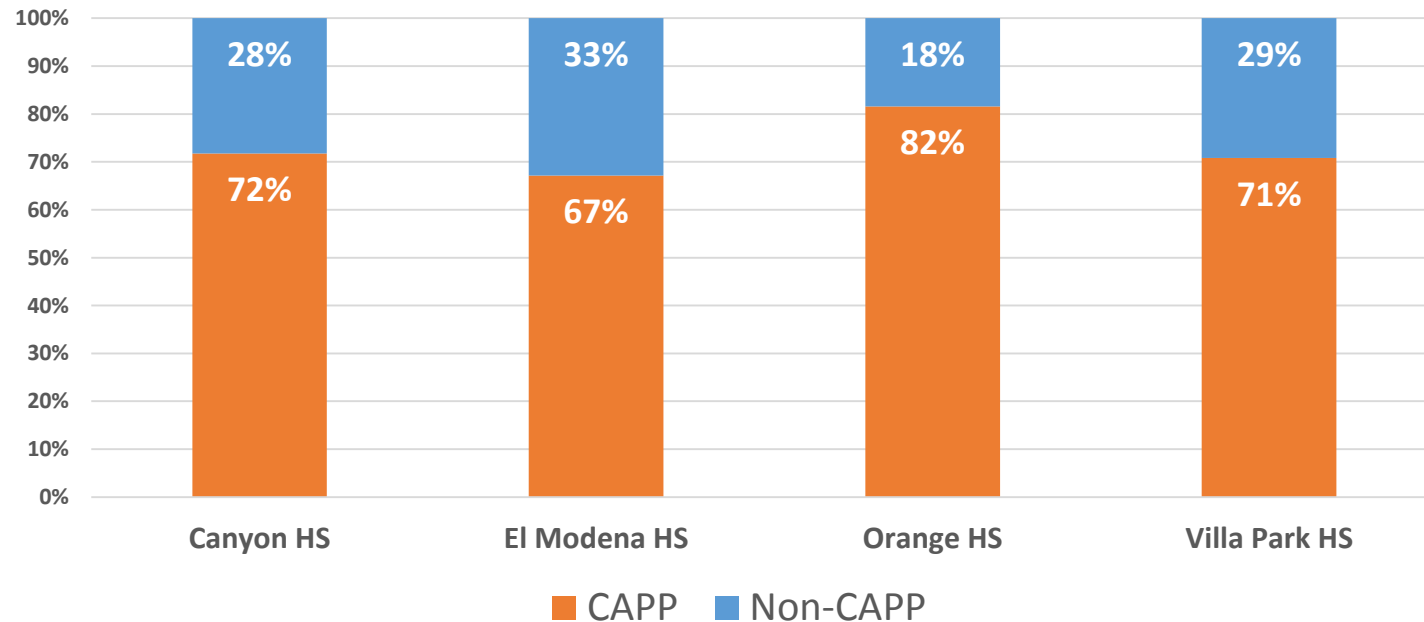


# Average Age of CAPP and Non-CAPP Students

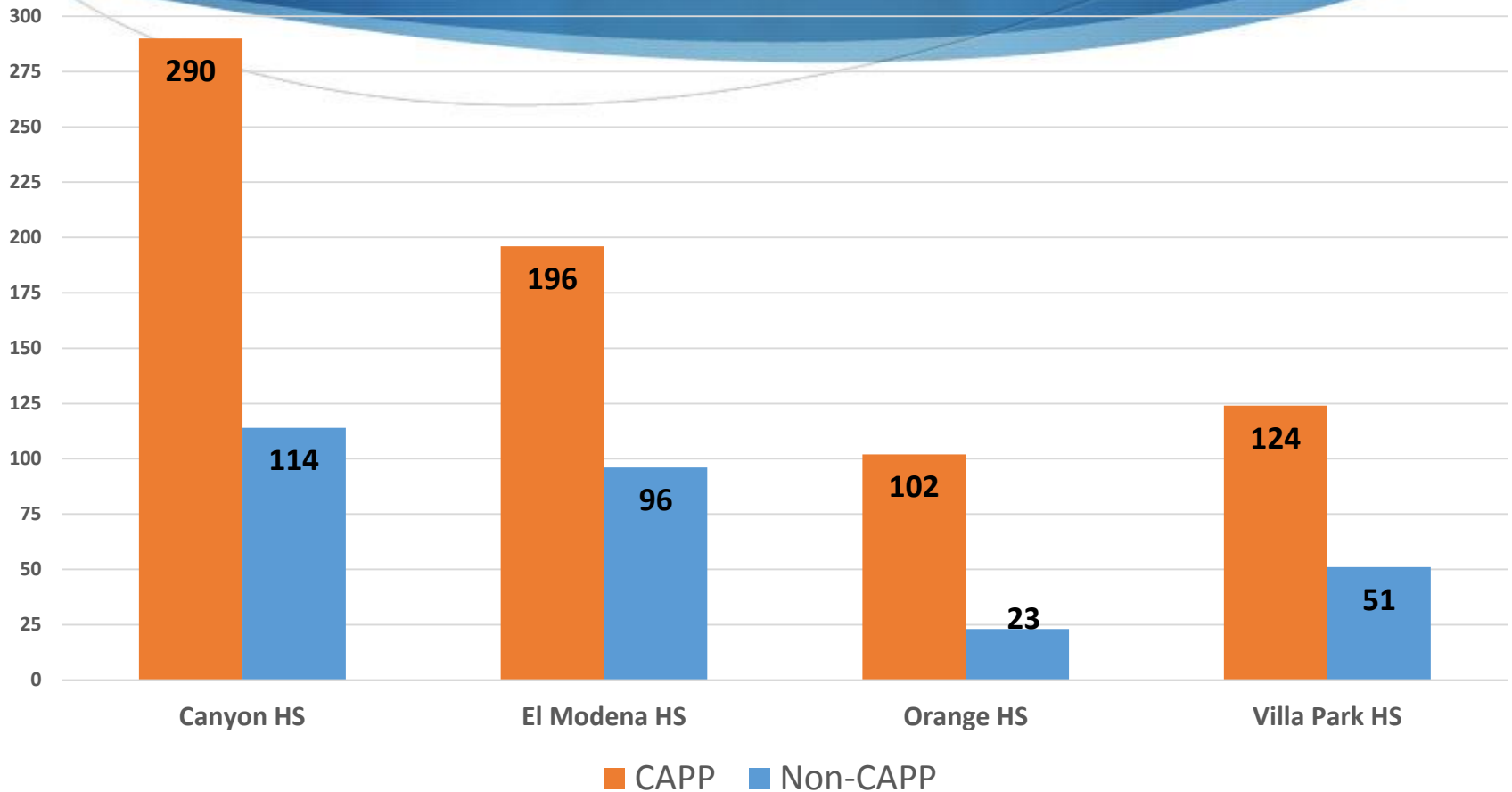


# OUSD Enrollment by Site Spring 2015- Fall 2016

## OUSD CAPP vs Non-CAPP Enrollment

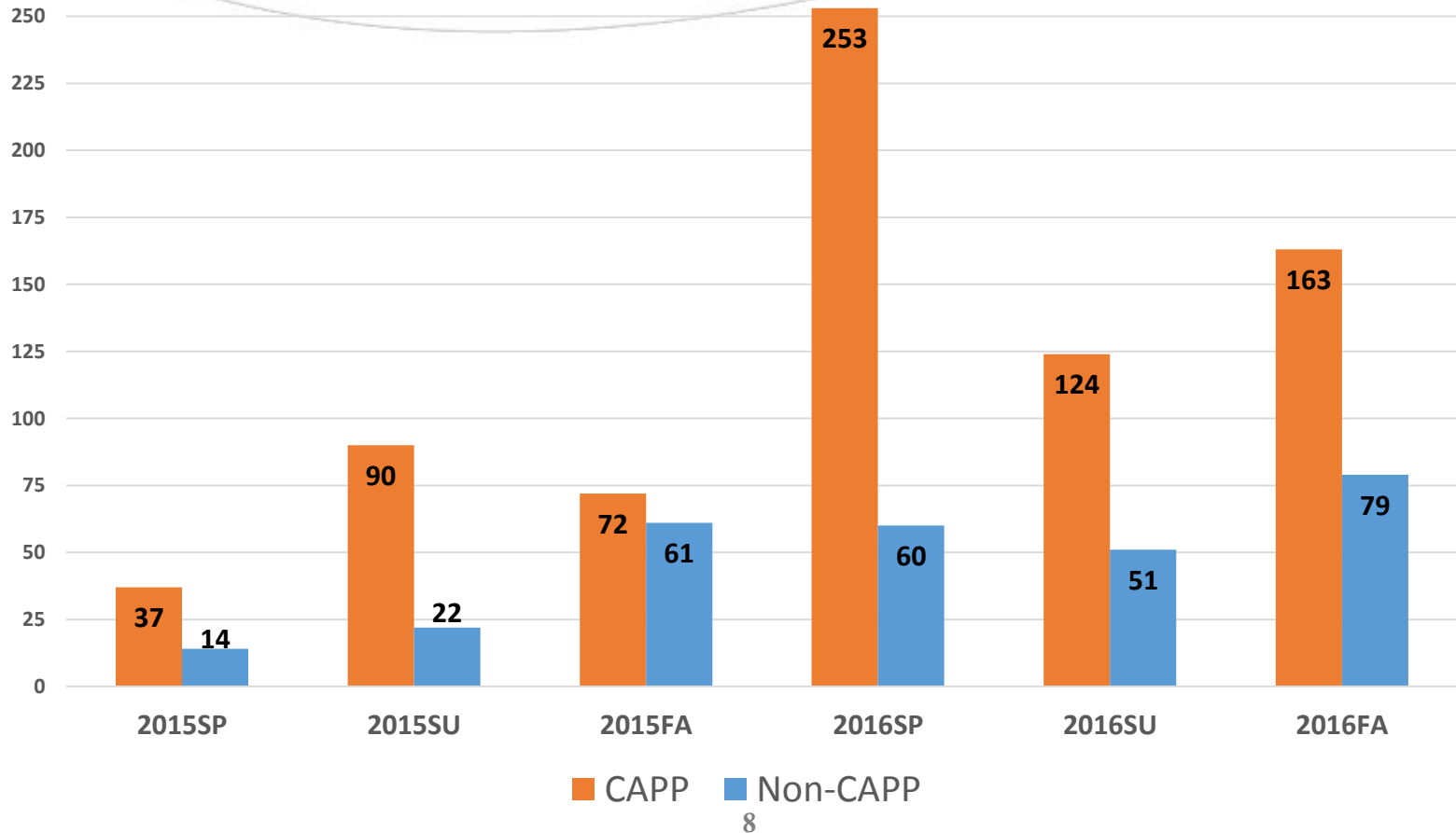


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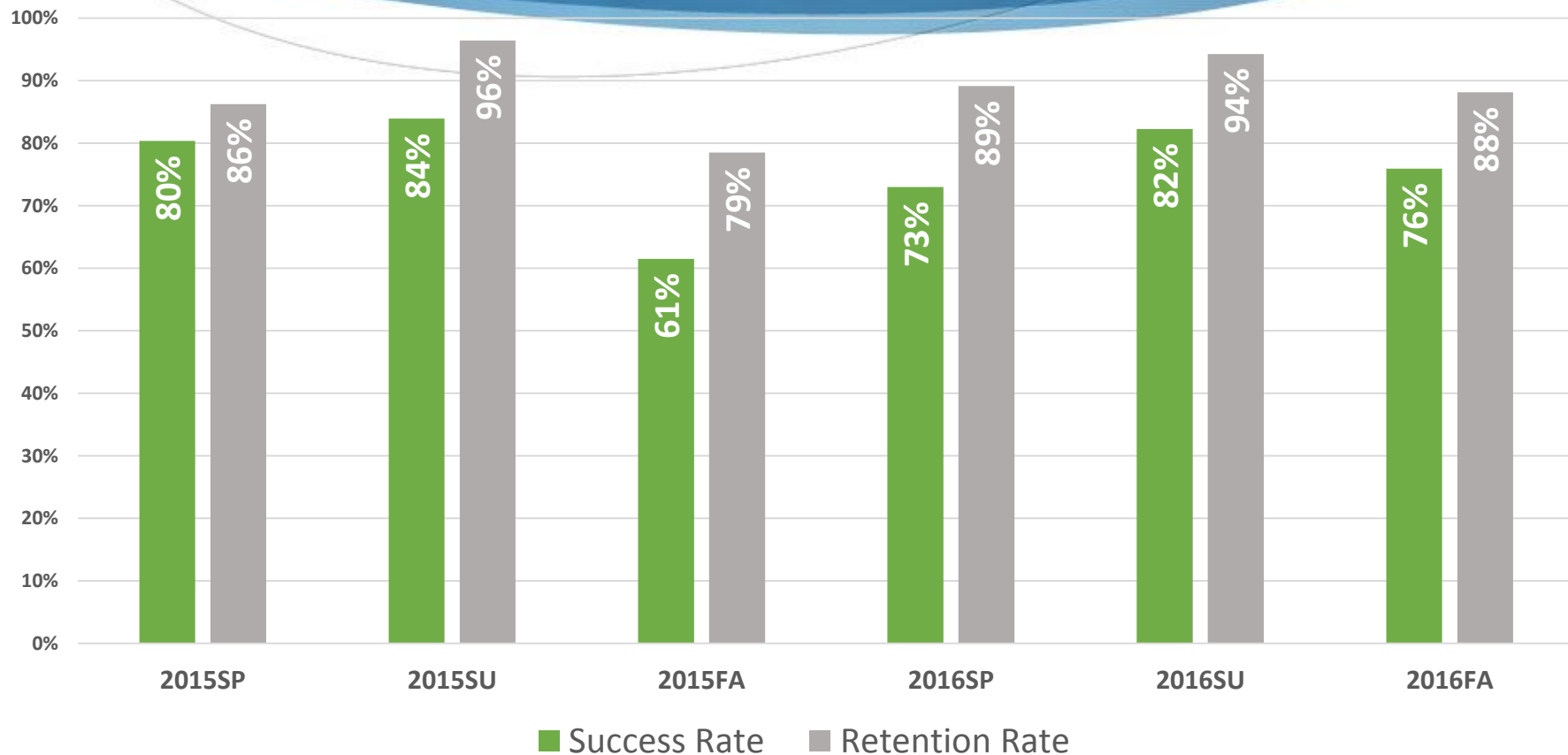
# OUSD Enrollment by Site

## Spring 2015- Fall 2016



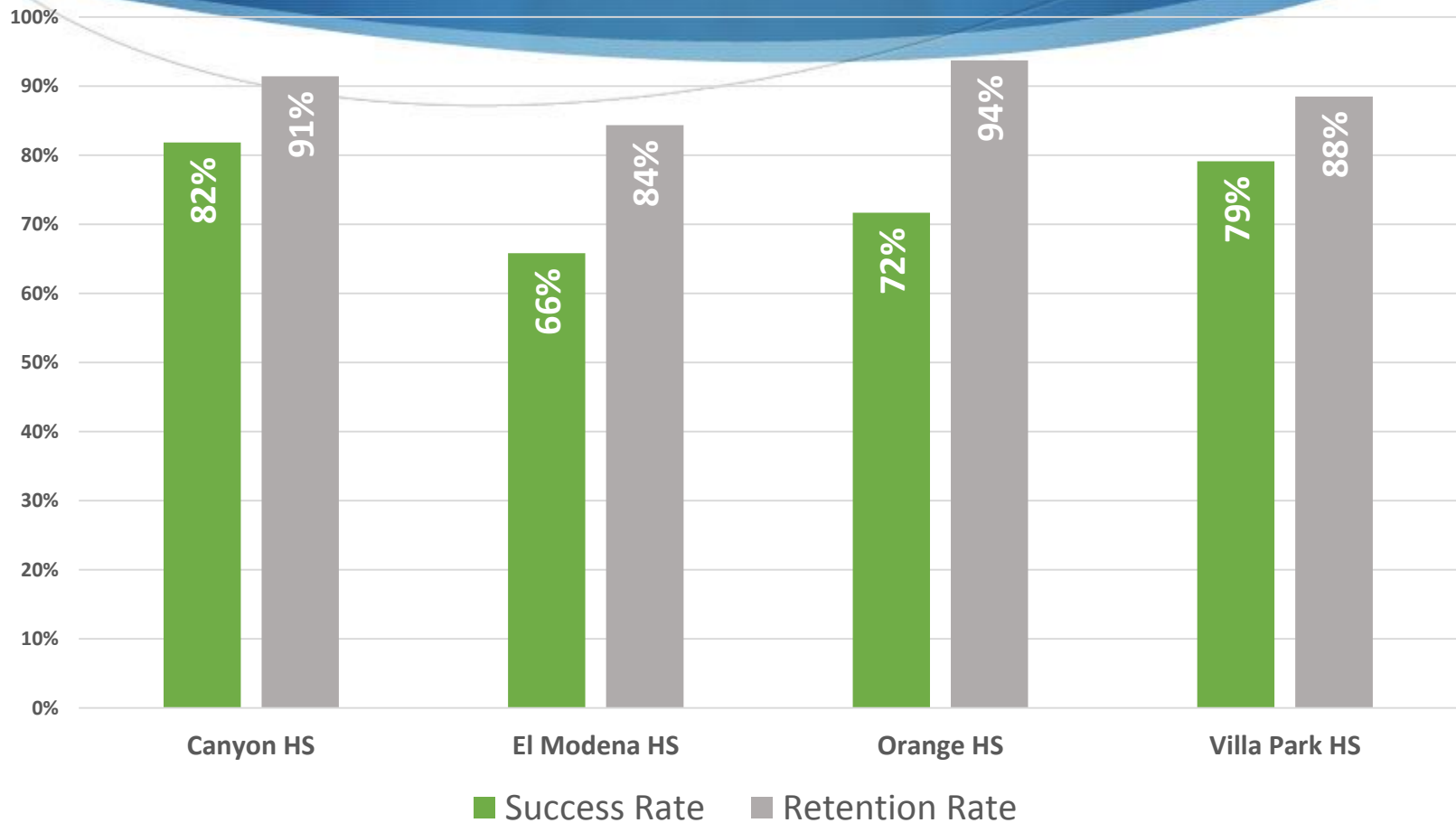


# Success and Retention Rates by Term for OUSD
