## CM – Specific Scope of Services

- Update "As-Built" Plans
  - Ground Penetrating Radar
  - ADA Compliance
  - Testing and Inspections
  - Soils Reports

#### **Term**

 From Board Approval of Contract to November 8, 2016 (approximately 1 year)

### Contract Value

Hourly "as needed" basis, not to exceed \$50,000
