The **CALIFORNIA HEALTHY YOUTH ACT (CHYA) of 2016** requires school districts to ensure that all pupils in grades 7-12, inclusive, receive comprehensive sexual health education and HIV prevention education at least once in high school and once in middle school.

ELEMENTARY

Comprehensive sexual health education and HIV prevention education is **not** taught in OUSD elementary schools.

MIDDLE SCHOOL

Positive Prevention Plus will be recommended to the Board of Education for approval for 2020-21 implementation.
