

DELAC MINUTES: May 26, 2023

- I. **The call to Order.** Elizabeth Garcia called the meeting at 9:06 A.M.
- II. **Welcome & opening ceremony.** Rafaela Rivera welcomed all the attendees and led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance
- III. **Approval of the minutes.** Candelaria Ramos asked attendees to review the minutes, which were approved • The motion to approve was made by Maria Morales and it was seconded by Adrianna Jimenez.
- IV. **Cal Assist.** Marcela Dunca. Explained Cal Assist matches families to free healthy food and other CALAIM benefits • demonstrated survey to take online to match what benefits a family is matched to • examples of what families can qualify for are medically-tailored food benefits • chef-curated tailored food options • no enough families are getting matched and the goal today is to make everyone aware of these benefits and try to match families to benefits • presenter answered questioned and stayed at meeting to help families get matched for benefits.
- V. **SCC Free-Tuition Programs.** Jesus Diego-Calixto • presented Early Welcome Program, early College, and business Career Education • Early Welcome Program gives priority registration to students before they graduate high school, a college counselor and transportation to college registration while in high school • Early College is an opportunity for high school students to take college level courses while still in high school which allows students to figure out their interest, save money and be better prepared for college • Business Career Education are free classes for all high school students • parents asked registration questions and presenter stayed after meeting to guide each parent who needed help.
- VI. **Safety and Complaint Procedures.** Heriberto Angel • detailed presentation that bullying is a behavior that happens repeatedly over time • most bullying today happens online on social media like IG, Facebook, and TikTok • other bullying is verbal, physical and social • what is not bullying is a one-time event, isolated physical events, a mutual argument against two people, or one episode of a social rejection • reportable events need to be reported to classroom teacher immediately to allow for an investigation to be going • all identities will be kept confidential and investigations can take up to 48 hours • when necessary school counselors, principals, or other staff will get involved • if parent is not contacted by anyone from the school within 48 hours parent should follow up • parents can go directly to school principal for any questions or further concerns • if parent feels school has not adequately dealt with the situation and parent has made multiple attempts to work with the school principal parents can call 714-628-5424 for further help • parents asked what they do when the problem keeps happening even after multiple attempts to work with school – Angel suggested they call the number listed to get more individual help on their concerns.
- VII. **ELOP/ASES Summer Programs.** Adolfo Herrera. After school programs will be offered at selected sites that will run for 3 hours • students can register starting May 1st and programs will run from June 20th to July 13 from 8:30-11:30 • cost is FREE but has limited space and tailored to specific needs of students • Breakfast will be from 7:30-8:30 and lunch from 11:30-12 • For questions parents can call 714-628-5715.
- VIII. **LCAP Questions/Feedback for Superintendent.** Abril Liu • following up on the presentation Sandy Schaffer conducted last meeting Liu asked parents for what further feedback they would like to give regarding the LCAP, specifically on how to spend English Learner monies • Liu handed out a survey and took public comments to formally write to superintendent of schools with parent feedback • parents expressed the need for more ongoing tutoring for students who are yet to reclassify • parent support classes on how to actively be engaged in the social emotional needs of our students • improved facilities • Liu advised all information given today will be taken to superintendent.
- IX. **Census.** Amber Tatch • presented the census information regarding the number of EL learners we have at OUSD and which language they speak • no questions were asked by audience.
