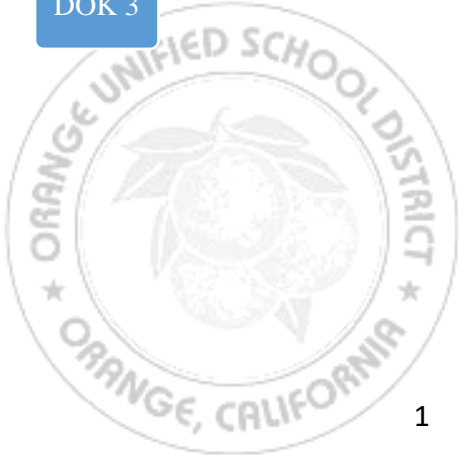
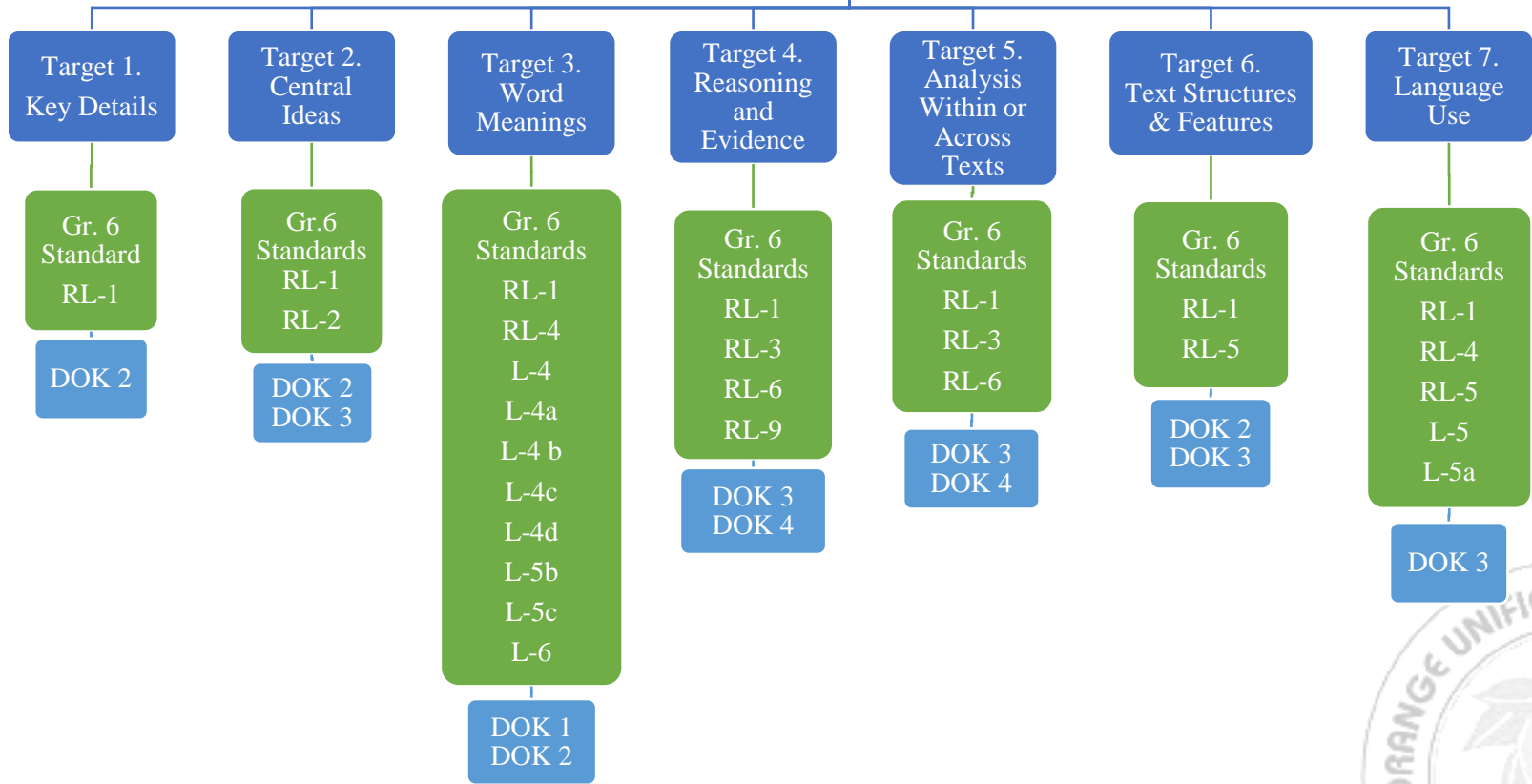


Literary Texts – Grade 6

 Students can read closely and analytically to comprehend a range of increasingly complex literary and informational texts.

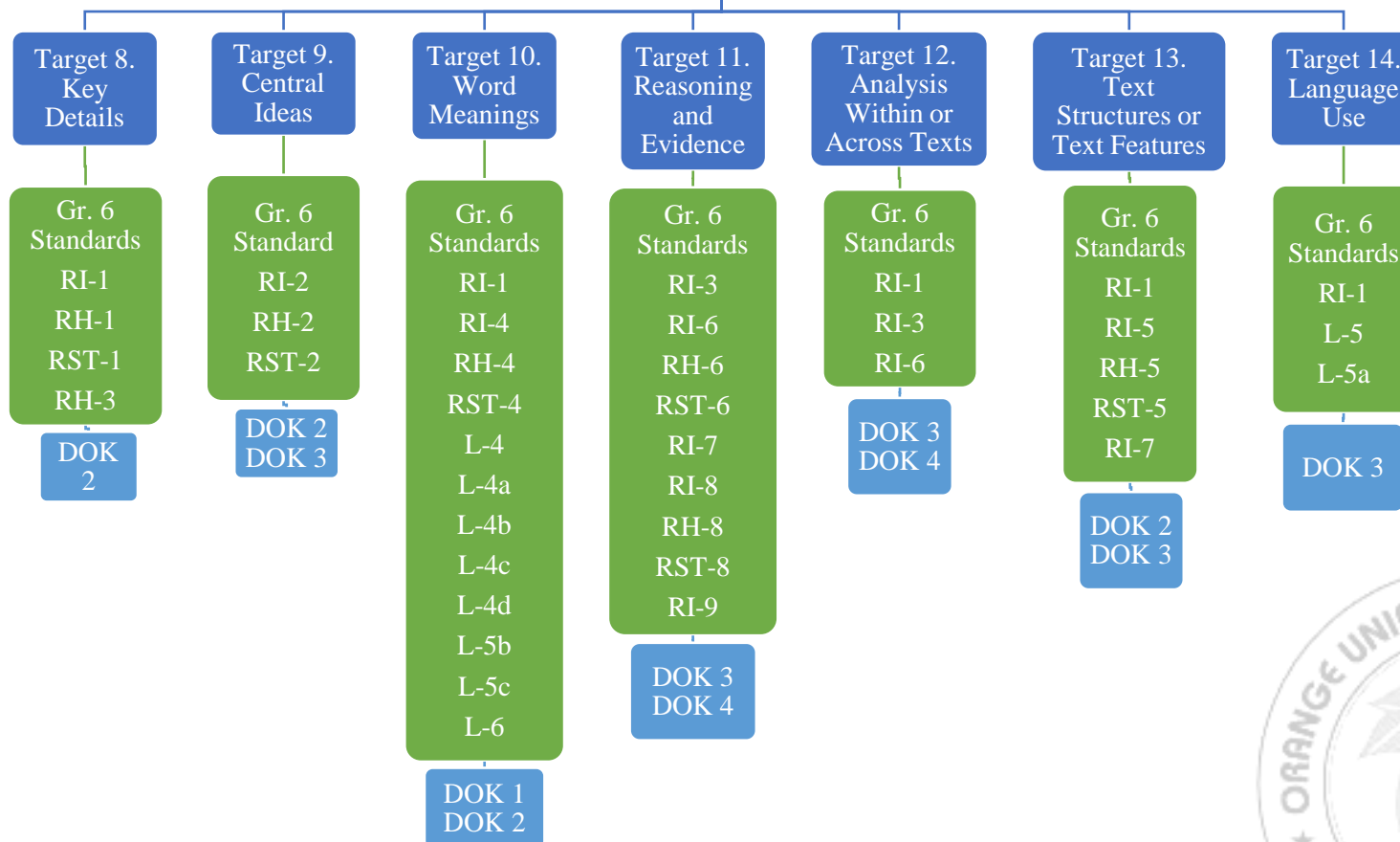


Informational Texts – Grade 6

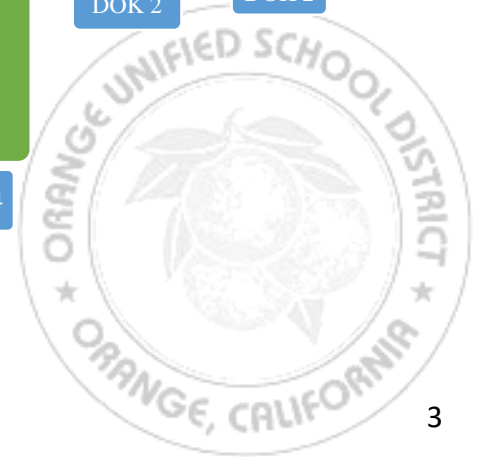
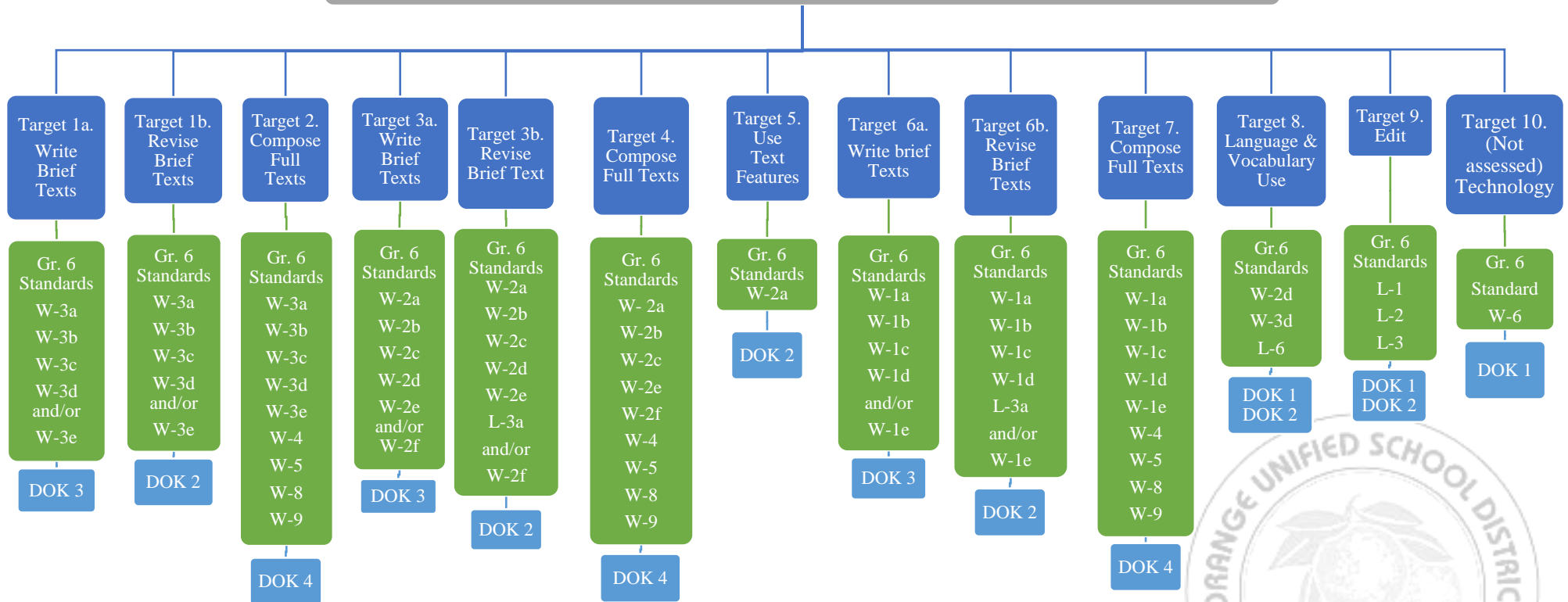
Writing – Grade 6

35 % of the assessment evidence will come from composing, revising, and/or editing explanatory/informational writing based on evidence from given sources.

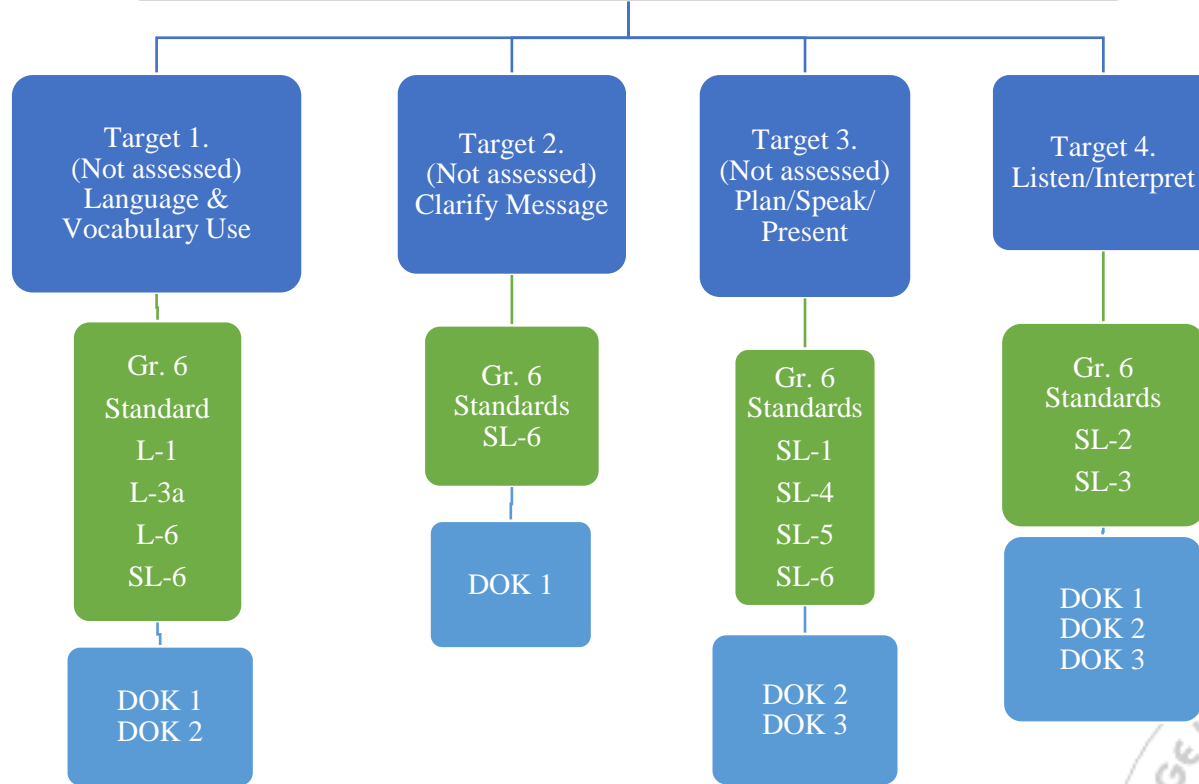
35% of the assessment evidence will come from composing, revising, and/or editing argumentative writing based on evidence from given sources.
