

OVERALL STUDENT AND PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

The following are expected of all students at all times:

School Rules

Students shall follow established rules at school, when they are on their way to and from school, and during school sponsored activities.

Quality of Work

Students shall, to the best of their ability, complete assigned lessons each day, including homework and assignments missed because of absences or tardies.

Quality of work will be

evident when students are actively engaged in the learning process. Students are to turn in

work in a neat and comprehensible manner.

Attendance and Absences

Students are expected to be at school every day on time. In the event of an absence, a satisfactory explanation from a parent or guardian shall be provided in writing to the school.

Students who accumulate absences and tardies will be counseled at school on the importance

of being at school every day and being on time. Excessive tardiness and absences will be monitored, disciplined, and if improvement does not occur, reported to the School Attendance

Review Board (SARB).

Relationships with Others

Students shall respect the rights and privileges of each person in the school. Good citizenship in school, as well as in the community, includes respect for the rights and property of others.

PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES

The following responsibilities are expected of parents:

Support the school by reviewing the school discipline rules and regulations with all family members to ensure that everyone is familiar with and understands the standards of conduct

expected by school personnel.

- Praise children at home who demonstrate appropriate behavior.
- Cooperate with and support school officials in carrying out appropriate discipline penalties when such action is necessary.
- Read and comply with all communications from the school, signing and returning them if requested.

- Cooperate with the school by attending scheduled conferences regarding your child's progress.
- Communicate with teachers and office staff in a caring, polite manner.
- Follow parking lot procedures at all times to ensure the safety of all students and adults.
