The course also provides and immersion in several artistic, creative, technical and psychological techniques linked to graphic design; Adobe Illustrator, Adobe Photoshop, and Adobe InDesign will be the primary software. Foundation of Digital Design is centered on skill and technique development. Students will apply basic skills to design problems: posters, personal logos, magazine layout, photo editing, and product labels.




